Conditions: "Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated Campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the secretary of the host committee within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$20 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$20 is forfeited". All money is refundable if scratchings are received by Friday 12th May. Otherwise \$15.00 per nomination will be retained from this date. Scratchings from Tuesday 16th May will be forfeited, unless extenuating circumstances apply. Note: Nominations may close early or alterations may be made to the program as per ACA regulations if excess numbers are received. **ALL PRIZE MONEY WILL BE ALLOCATED AS PER ACA RULE R.9 (b). 12 RUNS (NOT INCLUDING THE RESTRICTED OPEN & FUTURITY) PER COMPETITOR.** The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse with exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement Campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating e.g. if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft. All persons Under the Age of 18 years MUST wear a HELMET at all times whilst on the Campdraft grounds. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
